CooperVision Opens LEED Master Site Plant in Costa Rica ***Energy-Efficient Manufacturing Facility Employs Approximately 250 Local Residents***

PLEASANTON, CALIF., June 15, 2016 — CooperVision, one of the world's leading manufacturers of soft contact lenses, has opened a newly constructed, energy efficient, 100,000-square-foot manufacturing plant at Coyol Business Park in Alajuela, Costa Rica, the company announced today.

CooperVision's core project team honored Costa Rica's commitment to sustainability with energy-efficient utilities and materials in the facility's design, including a high-efficiency luminary system with natural light support in its main corridors, a vegetable oil-powered main transformer to reduce energy and environmental waste, rain water tanks for toilets and waterless urinals, and a lubricated air compressor to cut energy consumption.

The plant's operating processes were designed for energy conservation, as well. Up to 90 percent of solid waste and 100 percent of plastic components generated by the manufacturing process will be recycled, and over 90 percent of electricity consumed at the plant will be generated from renewable sources, including hydroelectric power stations. The plant has a reduce, reuse, recycle waste management program, and is a tobacco-free campus with motorcycle facilities and a dedication to mass transportation for employees. Environmentally-friendly chemicals and processes will be used for pest control, and indoor environmental quality processes are in place for manufacturing rooms.

There is potential for the company to expand as the needs of the plant grow. CooperVision partnered with local architects in Alajuela to plan smart growth and sustainable development plans to maximize land use and minimize environmental impact.

"Our newest manufacturing facility is a showcase for how forward-looking companies can be stewards for environmentally sustainable practices," said Fernando Torre, chief operations officer for CooperVision. "Costa Rica is globally respected for its environmental commitments, and CooperVision is privileged to share in its long-term vision for creating economic opportunity and growth in a responsible manner."

Costa Rica was chosen for the manufacturing site for its competitive infrastructure, stable economy, educated work force, and strong presence of medical device companies. The plant currently employs approximately 250 people.
